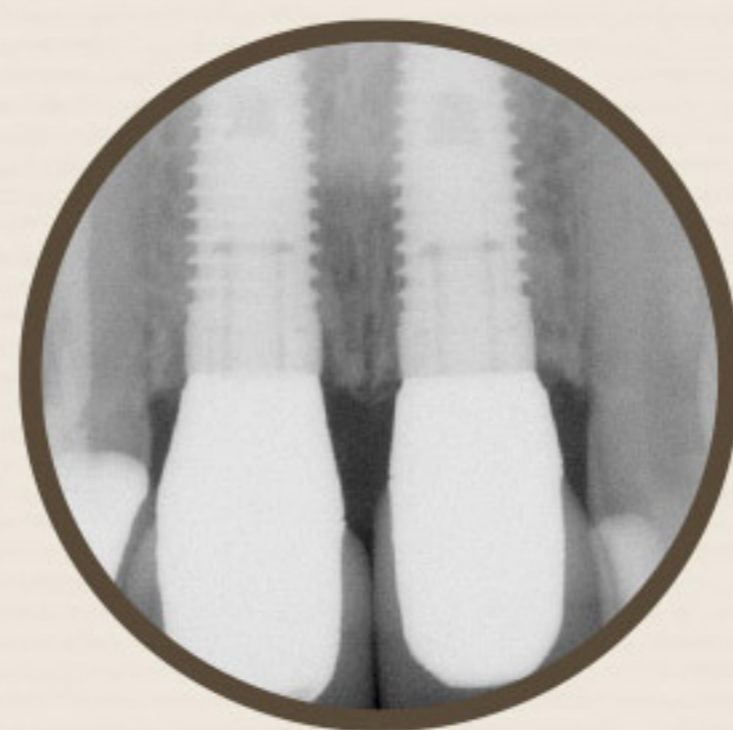
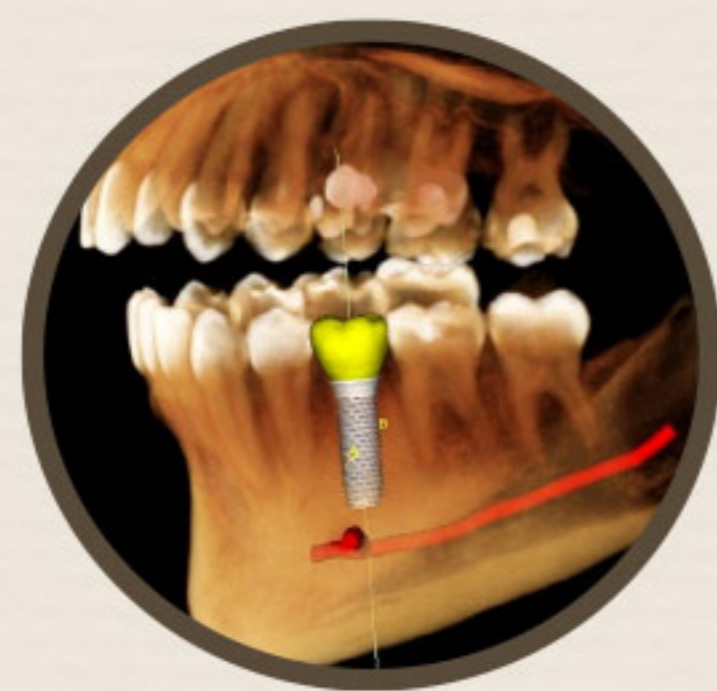

OUR SERVICES:

CT Scan: We consider it a standard of care to take 3-D images prior to placement of implants. This eliminates guesswork and allows for proper planning and placement.

Lasers: Not all lasers are created equal. We use the Millennium (LANAP) laser to target inflamed tissue and destroy specific periodontal pathogens to treat both periodontal disease and peri-implantitis.

Immediate Implants (anteriors/posteriors): Our team aims at reducing the number of procedures necessary for your patient while striving to achieve an ideal esthetic/functional result.

Sedation: We offer both Oral and IV sedation for patients that are anxious about surgery.

Full Arch Reconstruction (all-on-4): Treating a full arch can be an overwhelming task, which is why we have established a protocol to make this process easy and efficient for the dentist as well as the patient. We strongly value communication and will work closely with you from start to finish.

Soft Tissue Grafting: We use different techniques to address gingival recession, gummy smiles, and gingival asymmetry.

Ridge and Sinus Augmentation: Due to infection, anatomy, or a tooth that has been missing for some time, there may not be enough bone for implant placement. We can rebuild the foundation to allow for appropriate implant positioning and stability long term.

Crown Lengthening: We perform this procedure for both function and cosmetic reasons.

Same Day Emergencies: Our goal is to ensure prompt care and same day treatment. Whether it's an abscess or an extraction, we will accommodate your patients.

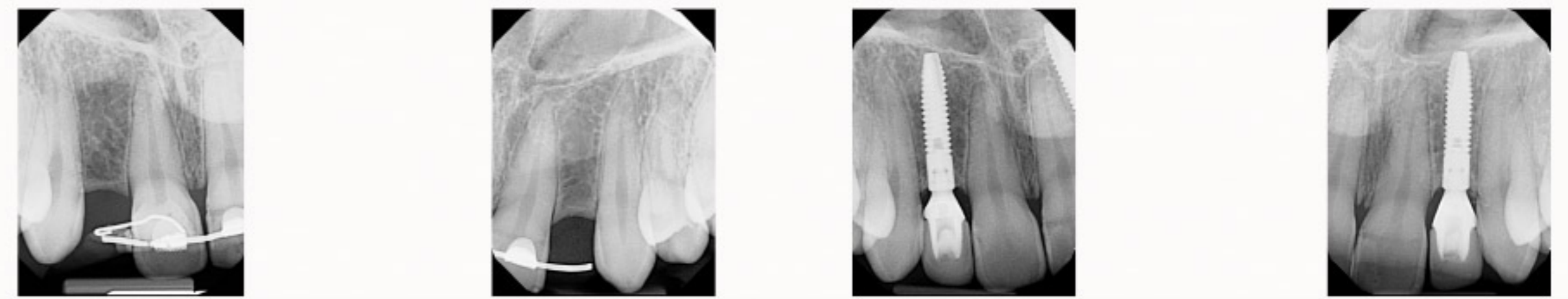

REPLACING CONGENITALLY MISSING TEETH:

Replacing congenitally missing teeth, especially in the esthetic zone, can be a challenging endeavor. We often use specialized narrow diameter implants to allow for proper emergence and esthetics. As a team we have developed a checklist to ensure our patients obtain an optimum result. Please contact us for additional information regarding this treatment.

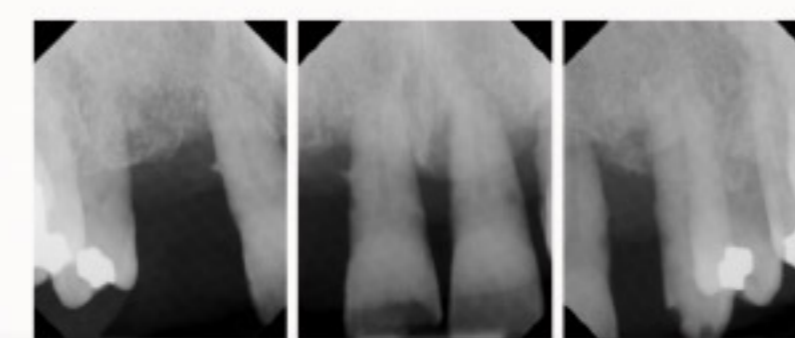

FULL ARCH RECONSTRUCTION:

This patient's primary concern was not being able to chew food and he was terrified about the idea of wearing dentures. Working closely with his dentist and the lab, we were able to restore his smile with an all-on-six on the upper arch and an all-on-four on the bottom arch. He was restored with a lab made, wire reinforced, provisional the day after surgery. Following 6 months of healing, he was transitioned into a bar supported final prosthesis.

TREATING PERI-IMPLANTITIS:

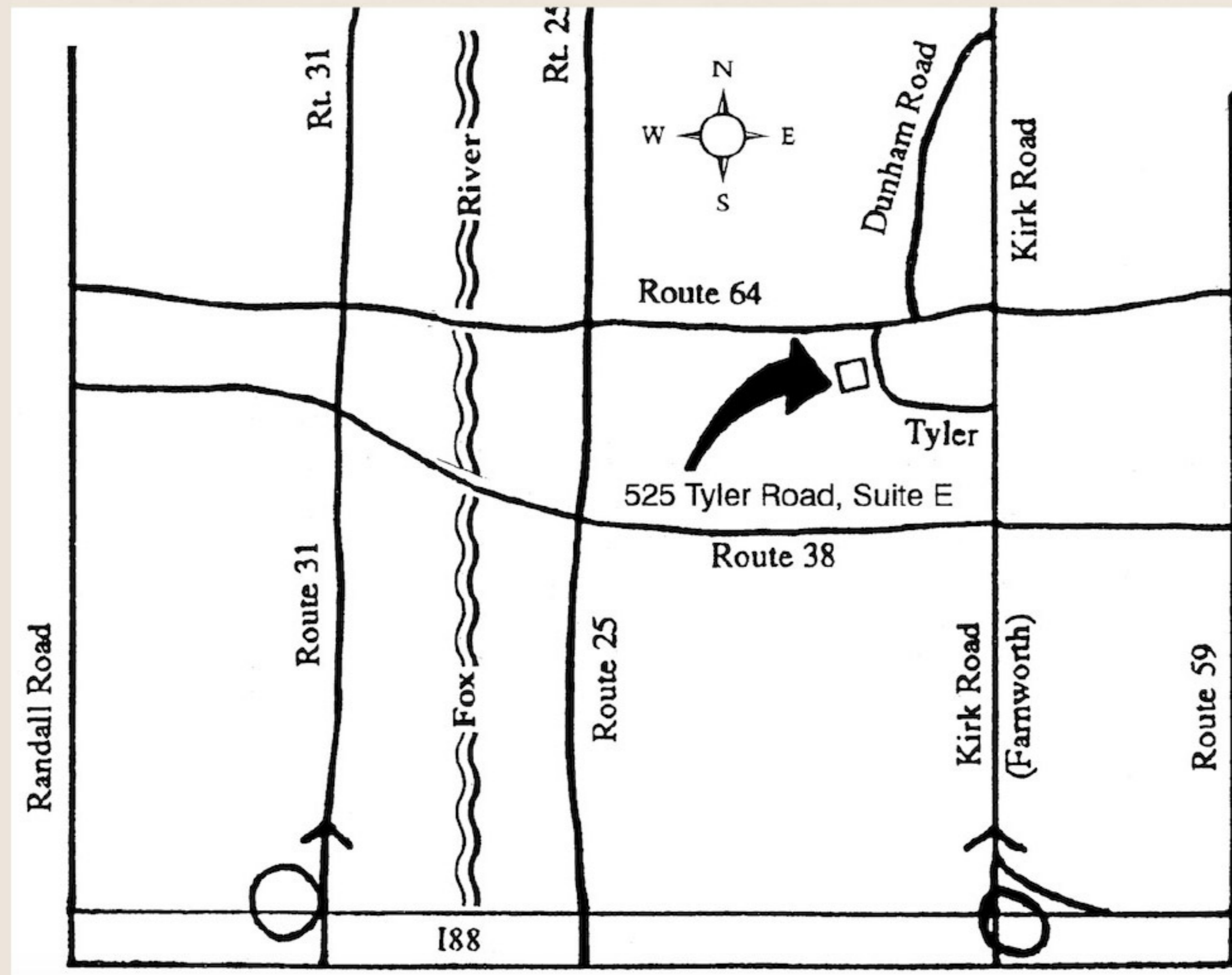
Traditionally, peri-implantitis is treated with a "kitchen sink" approach including flap surgery, bone grafts, membranes, etc... with oftentimes unpredictable results. Dr. Crosby, Kolinski, and Trahan have received extensive training with the Millennium Laser. The patient on the right was treated with the Millennium laser in one minimally invasive treatment without the use of grafts or membranes.
