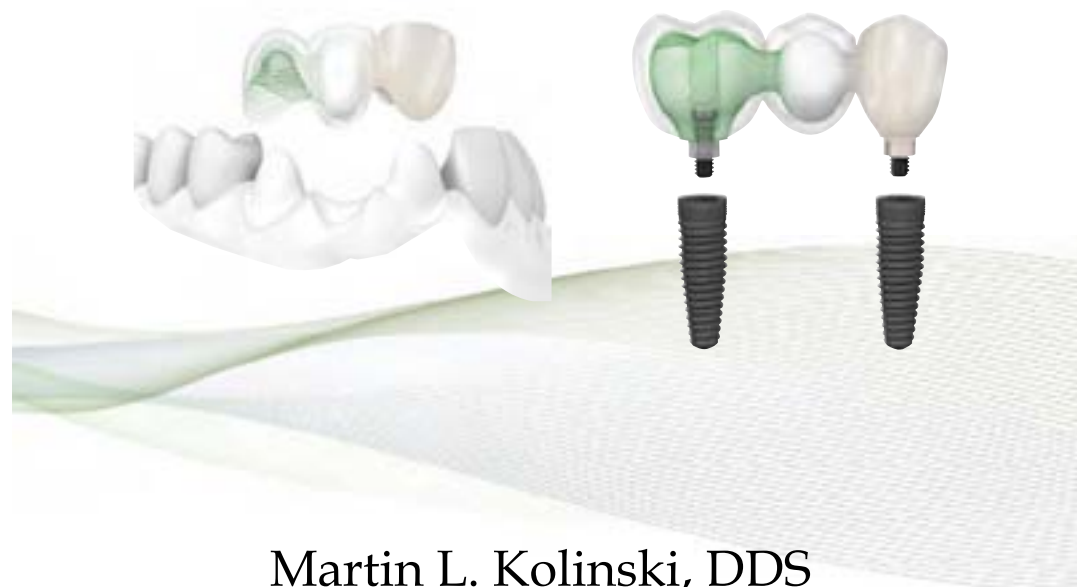
Brett Edwards, Nobel ProCera Specialist

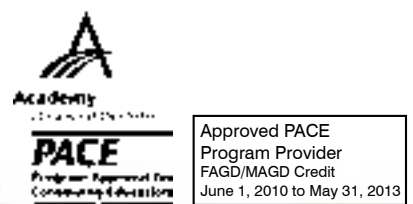
